



Vermicompost Uses

- You can use vermicompost immediately, or store it and use it later.
- It can be mixed into your garden soil and around your trees and plants.
- You can use it as a top dressing on outdoor plants or sprinkle it on your lawn as a conditioner.
- For top-dressing on indoor plants, you may want to remove decaying bedding and food scraps from the castings.
- If there are worms or eggs in the castings, return them to the worm bin.
- You can also make a “compost tea” to feed to your plants:
 - **METHOD 1:** Add 2 tablespoons of vermicompost to 1 quart of water. Allow it to steep for a day, and mix it occasionally. Water your plants with this “tea” to help make nutrients in the soil available to the plants.
 - **METHOD 2:** If you collect the moisture from the bottom of your bin, you can add water (3:1) and add it as liquid fertilizer to indoor or outdoor plants.
